Dear Parent,

We welcome you to Jubilee Hills Public School for the academic year 2019-20.

Kindly make a note and send the following:

- Complete set of books with stationery items (labeled with permanent marker) to be handed over to the class teacher by 03.04.19.
- A spare dress and a rough book (For communication till the new School Diary is provided) in the school bag daily.
- A water bottle, snack box and a napkin in a separate basket (This is compulsory as children will be taught table manners in the class). Label the basket and avoid sending junk food, boiled eggs, milk and juices.
- Send 3 passport size and 3 stamp size photos of the child (**photo to be taken in school uniform only**), 2 family photos of postcard size (Landscape) and also 3 stamp size photos of the child's father and mother. Please write the name, class and section of your child on the reverse side of each photo and send in an envelope to the class teacher by 06.04.19.

- School timings: From 1st April to 3rd April 7.55 a.m. to 10.30 a.m.
From 4th April onwards 7.55 a.m. to 12.15 p.m.
- Parents are requested to pick up their child everyday till transport details are intimated to the class teacher.
- Last working day: **09.04.19**
- Summer vacation is from **10.04.19 to 09.06.19 (both days inclusive)**
- School re-opens on Monday, **10.06.19** (7.55 a.m. to 12.15 p.m.).
School transport students will be boarded as per the afternoon bus routes from 10.06.19. Buses will leave the school premises at 12.25p.m.
